

1. CUT-OFF YEAR:

Elementary- 2001 – qualified

Secondary – 1996 – qualified

2. A school must enter in a minimum of three (3) sporting events per level in order to be accepted in the MILO Little Olympics.
3. Knock down system is to be applied in following sporting games (Basketball, Badminton, Football, Lawn Tennis, Scrabble, Sepak Takraw, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, and Volleyball).
 Athletics and Swimming events shall be based on Best Times.
 Gymnastics event shall implement its standard scoring system.
 Chess shall use the Swiss system.
4. Registration form shall be duly accomplished and signed by the School Principal/Registrar with school seal.
5. Registration fees:
 - a. basketball (new), Football, Volleyball at Php. 1, 000.00 each
 - b. other events at Php. 500.00 each
 - c. cheer dance at Php. 1, 000.00 each
6. All schools are required to submit a “Gallery” – a folder containing the following:
 - a. Three (3) pieces of a recent I.D. pictures size 2 x 2 photo of all participants with the corresponding names and team captain/s indicated below each name.
 - b. The registration form shall be properly filled up and duly certified by the particular team coach and the school registrar or principal.
 - c. NSO copy the birth certificate or passport for each of the student athletes
 - d. Photocopy of Form 137 signed by the principal/registrar.

7. A non refundable protest fee of Php 5, 000.00 shall be charged together with the written protest and the physical evidence before any action from the Tournament Manager or his duly authorized assistant (as approved by the Organizer) can be taken.
