Good day! The Capitol University Guidance Center in coordination with the Career Guidance Network 10 and the Department of Labor and Employment Region 10 will hold a **"Trainers' Training: Compassionate Caring for Substance Users"** on January 14, 2017, 8:00am-5:00pm at the Multi-Purpose Hall, Capitol University, Cagayan de Oro City with the theme: **"Life Rediscovery through Community-Based Intervention"**.

This one-day training is a "Barefoot Doctor" type of intervention which is embedded within the community, tapping human resources from the minutest level of the individual (drug addict), within the settings he revolves in (family, school, work, friends, community, church and society). Using the Bronfenbrenner Approach of Ecosystems of Development, this training will provide tools in:

1. Understanding the Psyche of a Drug Addict: Psychoeducation on the Nature of Substance Abuse and Risk-Factors Involved and Dual Diagnoses
2. Understanding the drug addict at different ages and stages of life: child addict, versus teen addict versus adult addict
3. Understanding the Self as a Compassionate Carer
4. Understanding different approaches by different professionals as key players in helping the drug addict
5. Looking at different evidence-based interventions/therapies; community-based interventions.

The target participants to this activity are public and private guidance counselors, teachers and local government officials (city, municipal, and barangay levels) who are key players in helping substance abusers.
